We provide a consistently high standard of teaching and treat all scholars with kindness and respect



All scholars have access to a knowledge-rich curriculum, which enables powerful learning



We provide a safe and supportive environment, whilst challenging scholars to achieve their full potential



We encourage all scholars to fully develop and realise their talents and aspirations, in order that they are successful at university or in professional employment



We provide parents/carers with regular reports and opportunities for discussion about their child's progress












We set regular home learning, whilst ensuring that scholars still have time to take part in sports, hobbies or interests



We contact home, both to acknowledge successes and to inform parents/carers if there are any concerns about a scholar's behaviour, progress, or attendance

Parents/Carers will ensure that:

-  Your child attends every day and arrives on time
-  Your child does not take family trips or holidays during term time
-  Your child has the correct uniform and equipment needed for the day
-  You support the school's mission. This means you have read and agreed to follow our policies and regulations on behaviour and uniform, including same day after school detentions
-  You model respectful interactions with all members of TFS staff
-  You provide a suitable environment for your child to work in at home and ensure that they complete their home learning. Please let us know if you require any support with this
-  You communicate regularly with TFS through engaging with Parents' Evenings, meetings, other events and the scholar planner
-  You share any important information with TFS and that your contact details are kept up-to-date
-  You support your child in participating in enrichment activities, trips and residential visits

Scholars will ensure that they:

-  Always work hard and follow our "How Tos" in every lesson and around the school
-  Treat all staff, scholars and visitors with respect, kindness and courtesy
-  Attend regularly, arrive on time, wear the correct uniform and bring in the correct equipment
-  Bring their planner into school every day and keep it up-to-date with home learning tasks
-  Behave responsibly, both at the school and when travelling to and from TFS
-  Respect the school's buildings and equipment, ensuring that all spaces are left tidy and free of litter
-  Complete all home learning to the highest standard and meet all deadlines
-  Ensure that letters and other messages home are delivered to their parents/carers.
-  Take an active part in TFS life, including enrichment activities, clubs, teams, trips and residential visits.
-  Keep mobile phones switched off and in your bags and lockers during the school day.

Failure to keep to the Home School Agreement will result in disciplinary action and ultimately, the loss of a place at the Turner Free School.
