PE Kit and Uniform Expectations

Please be aware that all scholars have been reminded this week of our expectations in terms of uniform and PE kit. Unfortunately, we have started to see an increase in the number of scholars wearing items of clothing that are not part of our uniform, particularly on days when they have PE. All scholars need to be wearing full school uniform or PE kit, as outlined on our website and in our Family Handbook. Scholars cannot wear alternative leggings, tracksuit bottoms or hoodies and must have the items which are sold via Price and Buckland only.

We have allowed a grace period since September to allow parents and carers the opportunity to order and receive uniform items whilst Price and Buckland were having some difficulties fulfilling orders due to Covid-19. Price and Buckland have now confirmed that there are no outstanding orders for TFS families. Therefore, as of Monday 30th November, scholars will receive behaviour points for having incorrect uniform or PE kit. If you place an order to replace items, please provide confirmation of this via tfspastoral@turnerschools.com so that we are aware and your child will not receive behaviour points whilst you are waiting for delivery. If you require support with ordering items, please contact the Pastoral team. Year 9 parents and carers should be aware that failure to have the correct uniform will result in your child not being entitled to Turner Time.

Sweets and energy drinks

We ask that you do not provide your son or daughter with sweets or energy drinks as we do not allow them to consume these whilst at school. These items will be confiscated.
